## **Glossary**

<b>Browser</b>	The application you are using to surf the internet, e.g. Internet Explorer, Firefox.
<b>Client</b>	The person that is going to be viewing your website end product. Can sometimes be referred to as End User.
<b>Copy</b>	The words or content written to explain what the page is about.
<b>DCM</b>	Database Content Management - a separate administration that holds additional content
<b>eCommerce</b>	Level 3 of the Konstruk product. This is used for online shopping.
<b>End User</b>	The person that is going to be viewing your website end product. Can sometimes be referred to as Client.
<b>Icon</b>	The pictorial image of a node.
<b>Navigation</b>	Sometimes referred to / known as menu. This is how your client gets around your website.
<b>Node</b>	The item that is in the tree of your website administration. It has different icons depicting what type of node it is. i.e. Page, Image, File etc.
<b>RGB / FF</b>	The internet uses RGB color reference as opposed to the print industry that uses predominately CMYK. The FF # is the number that is made up of the RGB color pallet.
<b>Search Engine</b>	Google, Bing, Yahoo etc. Where the End User or Client finds your website via an internet search.
<b>SEO</b>	Search Engine Optimisation - where you tell Google, Yahoo, Bing etc about your website and get them to place your website higher on the page.
<b>Tree</b>	The hierachal structure of your website. A visual representation of the navigation on your website in the administration console.
<b>URL</b>	The address that is type into the address bar of your browser, i.e. <a href="http://www.abc.co.nz/home">www.abc.co.nz/home</a> .
